How do I begin

You can leave a legacy gift to WWF-Singapore in two main ways:

1. Leaving a sum of money/a percentage of your estate to WWF in your Will

You may choose to include **WWF-World Wide Fund for Nature (Singapore) Limited** in your Will. Whether you give a set amount or a percentage of your estate, you can have an extraordinary, positive impact on our natural world.

2. Naming WWF-Singapore as a beneficiary of your CPF or your insurance policies

You will need to fill out the CPF Cash Nomination Form [Form 6A(1)], which can be found on CPF's website or at any CPF branch office. Please visit the CPF Nomination Scheme website for more details and step-by-step instructions.

Similarly, you may also nominate WWF-Singapore as a beneficiary of your life insurance via your policy nomination form.

Please note that legacy gifts are generally designated as unrestricted, allowing WWF-Singapore to direct support towards our highest conservation priorities and strategic initiatives where it is needed most. If you would like your gift to support a specific area of work, such as wildlife conservation, landscape restoration, or environmental education, you may indicate your preference in your Will or nomination form.

While we are committed to honouring any specific wishes attached to your gift, we encourage you to avoid tightly defined restrictions, as these may limit our ability to maximise the long-term impact of your generosity in response to evolving conservation needs. If you wish for your legacy gift to support initiatives in Singapore exclusively, please state clearly in your Will or nomination form that your gift is intended for the WWF's Conservation Fund. Alternatively, you may write to us at philanthropy@wwf.sg to communicate your intentions. Together, let's create a world where people and nature thrive.
